Introduction

Senior Year Admitted (SYA) places offered by the UGC-funded universities are specifically allocated for graduates of sub-degree programmes articulating to degree programmes based on the credit transfer system of each individual receiving institution.

In view of the specific needs of prospective and current SYA students on credit transfer, the Cross Institutional Credit-transfer Information System (CICIS) has been developed for your smooth transition process from sub-degree study to degree study and academic planning.

How to search information on CICIS ?

Search Panel can be found on the homepage or Search page.

Step 1: Choose your search direction

You can search credit transfer records from either Associate Degree / Higher Diploma or Bachelor degree.

Step 2: Selection of Institution

Scroll or type to search and select any college / university (alphabetical order). Steps of both directions are the same.

Step 3: Selection of Programme

Scroll or type to search and select any programme (alphabetical order) offered by the selected college / university.
